2 Register online for surgery

3 Pre-Admit / Labs

All patients must undergo Pre-Admit testing and lab work, prior to their surgery.

You will obtain your lab order from your surgeon when you are scheduled for surgery or the orders will be mailed to you from the clinic prior to your surgery.

4 Pre-admit / Labs... When?

Your pre-admit testing and lab work must be completed within 30 days and no less than 7 days of your scheduled surgery.

**The Specialists Pre-Admit Department does not schedule appointments; patients are seen on a first come, first serve basis.*

6 Pre-admit / Labs... What to bring?

You will need to bring the following with you on the day you come for your Pre-admit testing & lab work:

- Orders and completed paperwork from your surgeon
- Photo ID & Insurance card
- Current medications/ supplements in their original bottles

You do not have to fast for Pre-Admit Testing & Labs

7 The Exam

You will complete a urinalysis, blood work & an EKG.

A Specialists Nurse will review all medications you are currently taking and advise about medications that should be discontinued prior to your surgery.

If there are any discrepancies with your testing, your surgeon will contact you prior to surgery.

** A Specialists Pre-Admit Nurse will call ou the day before your surgery between 10 am and 4 pm to confirm your surgery arrival time. If your surgery falls on Monday, they will call the Friday before your surgery.*
